

The Union Notes	<ul style="list-style-type: none">As per the Standing Orders, the Union has an Executive Committee consisting of the 4 full-time officers and the chairs of the Student Council and Student Voice ForumThe Union Executive is convened once every two weeks and make decisions on issues raised to them by Student Council or Student Voice ForumIn the event of Student Council or Student Voice Forum being inquorate, the Union Executive are tasked with voting on student submitted policies.The quoracy of Union democratic meetings, including Student Council, Student Voice Forum and Union Executive Committee meetings is 50% +1So far the 2023/24 academic year, all Student Council Meetings have been inquorate.
The Union Believes	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Absences can occur within the Union Executive CommitteeIn extraordinary circumstances, Executive Officer resignations or prolonged absence could result in the Union Executive Committee being inquorate and not being able to pass policyIn the event of the Union Executive Committee being inquorate, decisions cannot be passedThere is a risk that should Union Executive Committee be inquorate then a decisions made by Student Council will not be able to pass.
The Union Resolves	<ul style="list-style-type: none">The Standing Orders are amended so that in extraordinary circumstances where Union Executive Committee can not function due to a lack of members, student lay members are co-optedLay-members are appointed through the process of co-option and are in place for the term they are appointed in.Lay members will hold all the responsibilities of an Executive Committee member outlined in the Standing OrdersAny student who is not subject to revocation of Union membership can apply to be co-opted as a Lay member.A maximum of two lay members can be appointed in one term.




