The Union Notes	<i>Historically the SU trustee board has struggled to fill all the vacancies for the student trustee positions. It has been brought forth on many occasions that the role is not adequately incentivised and that there is little benefit to students for applying for the role. The current landscape of student trustee roles within our university presents a valuable opportunity for student involvement in the SU's governance and leadership. However, the recruitment and retention of student trustees have faced challenges, and it is imperative to address these issues to ensure a sustained interest in these roles. One risk free incentive that has been identified is the implementation of a policy wherein the Chair of the Trustee Board is to write a reference letter for all student trustees at the end of the academic year. As a means to attract students who are interested in seeking to develop their professional portfolio.</i>
The Union Believes	<i>The proposer and the student body share a collective belief on the importance of student voice in the governance of the SU. The union recognises that students need to see the benefits of being a trustee to apply. The introduction of a policy mandating the Chair of the Trustee Board to write reference letters/be a referee for all student trustees at the end of the academic year is seen as a crucial and meaningful incentive to entice students to run in the elections for these roles.</i>
